# **Current Budget Assumptions for 2023-2024**

- Teachers' Retirement System (TRS) estimated rate change from 10.29% to between 9.5 to 10.0% of salaries paid
- Average ERS rates estimated increase from 11.6% to 13.1% of salaries paid
- No tax cap exclusion for either retirement system
- The Annual Change in the CPI-U for 2022 was 6.5%

## 2023-24 Current Budget Assumptions (continued)

- Salaries: Current collective bargaining agreements in place and estimates for contracts ending June 30, 2023
- Contractual: No increase in contractual services including utilities
- BOCES Services: estimated 4–5% increase in BOCES services
- Special Education Tuition: 3-4% based on historical increases
- Supplies: No increase in funding
- Debt Service: No additional borrowings
