#### **Current Budget Assumptions for 2024-2025**

- Teachers' Retirement System (TRS) estimated rate change from 9.76% to between 9.5 to 10.25% of salaries paid
- Average ERS rates estimated increase from 13.1% to 15.2% of salaries paid
- Potential tax cap exclusion for ERS retirement system
- The Annual Change in the CPI-U for 2023 was 3.1%
- End of CRRSA2, GEER2 and ARP Federal Grants

# 2024-25 Current Budget Assumptions (continued)

- Salaries: Current collective bargaining agreements in place and estimates for contracts ending June 30, 2024
- BOCES Services: estimated 5-7% increase in BOCES services
- Special Education Tuition: 5-7% increase based on historical trends
- Health Insurance: estimated 5-8 % increase in costs
- Debt Service: No additional borrowings

- Retirement breakage
- Final TRS, ERS & Health Insurance Costs
- Transportation / Facilities Vehicle Purchases
- Final State Aid Allocations

- Line item by Function (i.e., Facilities, Guidance, Transportation, etc.) and by building
- Review Budget Modifications during budget process
- Draft Budget
- Final Superintendent recommended budget
- BOE adopted budget
- Three-part detailed budget format
